
## GROUND-SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

### KERAVA NATIONAL CRICKET GROUND

#### 1. Location of the ground

Address: Kettulankuja 8, Kerava.

#### 3. Facilities

Any unauthorized use of the facilities results in a 150 Euro fine to the club(s) involved. The facilities are remotely monitored for security purposes.

Observe the 30km/h speed limit on the residential streets leading to the ground. This is essential for our relations with the resident community.

Parking is allowed only on the parking lot. Do not park your car next to the pavilion.

**Smoking is only allowed** in the immediate area outside the entrance to the clubhouse, where an outdoor ashtray has been placed. All cigarette butts must be extinguished and placed in the ashtray.

Opening and closing the pavilion

- The scorers' room door is unlocked remotely (refer to separate instructions sent to clubs)

- Do not open the door unless you have the alarm code at hand, ready to disarm the alarm
  - o All security company callouts will be invoiced from the home team at cost
- The alarm system must be rearmed when leaving the ground
  - o Before rearming, check that all windows and blinds have been closed, doors have been locked, and the master key has been returned to the scorers' room coat hook next to the door

#### The scorers' and umpires' room

- The room is reserved only for umpires and scorers; no other persons are allowed for reasons other than unlocking the facility before the match and closing it afterwards
- The only match equipment kept in this room are spare stumps for breakages
- Scorers and umpires may only use the laptop computer, the iPad, and the radios for scoring purposes; all other equipment in the room is strictly off-limits
- The floor must be brushed, and bins emptied after match use
- Windows and blinds must be closed after each match

#### Dressing rooms

- Match equipment (stumps and bails, infield marker discs, umpiring equipment etc) are located in the home team dressing room, and it must be returned there after the match
- In accordance with the league fixtures, the home team uses the Koti/Home dressing room and the away team the Vieras/Away dressing room
- Dressing rooms must be cleaned after each use
  - o Rubbish must be taken outside to the dustbins in the shelter next to the pavilion and waste bags replaced from the rolls in the base of the dustbin
  - o The floors must be brushed clean
- Shower areas must be dried with a mop/squeegee and windows closed
  - o Toilet bowls and basins must be left clean and tidy
- Due to limited space, personal or club kit must not be left in the dressing rooms

#### Terrace, lounge, and kitchen

- The terrace must be left as found, with chairs stacked and umbrellas closed and tied up
- Shoes must be taken off on the carpet when you enter the lounge
- Clubs are to bring their own disposable plates, cups, knives, and forks for league matches
- If pots and pans from the kitchen are used, they are to be washed, dried, and returned to their original places
- The top half of the white refrigerator next to the lounge door is for club use during league matches, and it must be emptied after each match — any drinks already in the top half are to be consumed only after paying for them to the cash box
- All areas must be left tidy after use
  - o Rubbish must be taken out to the dustbin in the shed and waste bags replaced from the roll of bags in the base of the dustbin
  - o The floor must be brushed clean, and if necessary, mopped
  - o Toilet bowls and basins must be left tidy and cleansed of any stains
- Windows and blinds must be closed after use

#### Groundwork room behind the scorers' room

- This room is not in general use and should not be accessed at all during league matches

It is strictly forbidden to use any other part of the ground than an actual toilet as a toilet.

#### **4. Field preparation**

Remove the outfield water sprinklers and mobile covers from the wicket, in accordance with the specific written instructions provided.

Discs located in the home dressing room should be placed on the infield boundary.

If the teams notice problems in the field preparation, they should notify the umpires who will in turn inform the LC.

#### **6. Field-specific Playing Conditions**

Only coloured chalk is permitted to be used for marking stump positions when taking guard. Using permanent markers or anything else will be considered damaging the pitch (section 41.14 of the PCs) and wilful mistreatment of the cricket ground (section 42.2.1) and penalized accordingly.

#### **7. Post-match duties**

The captain of the home team is responsible for:

- returning all equipment to their original locations and immediately reporting to the LC if something malfunctioned or was broken during the match
- ensuring that all premises, including outdoor areas, are clean and tidy, and that waste bags have been taken out and replaced
- ensuring the grass outfield water sprinklers are returned to the outfield paying careful attention to the written **KNCG club watering instructions**
- ensuring the mobile rain covers are in position depending on the day of the week and weather conditions, paying careful attention to the written **KNCG rain covers club instructions**
- ensuring before arming the alarm that all doors and windows are closed, blinds drawn, and the master key replaced to the first coat hook in the scorers' room
- arming the alarm before leaving the premises and ensuring that the scorers' room door is locked after it has been closed

#### **8. Fines for non-compliance**

If these instructions are not complied with, the home team shall be levied a fine of 100 euros per infraction.
