

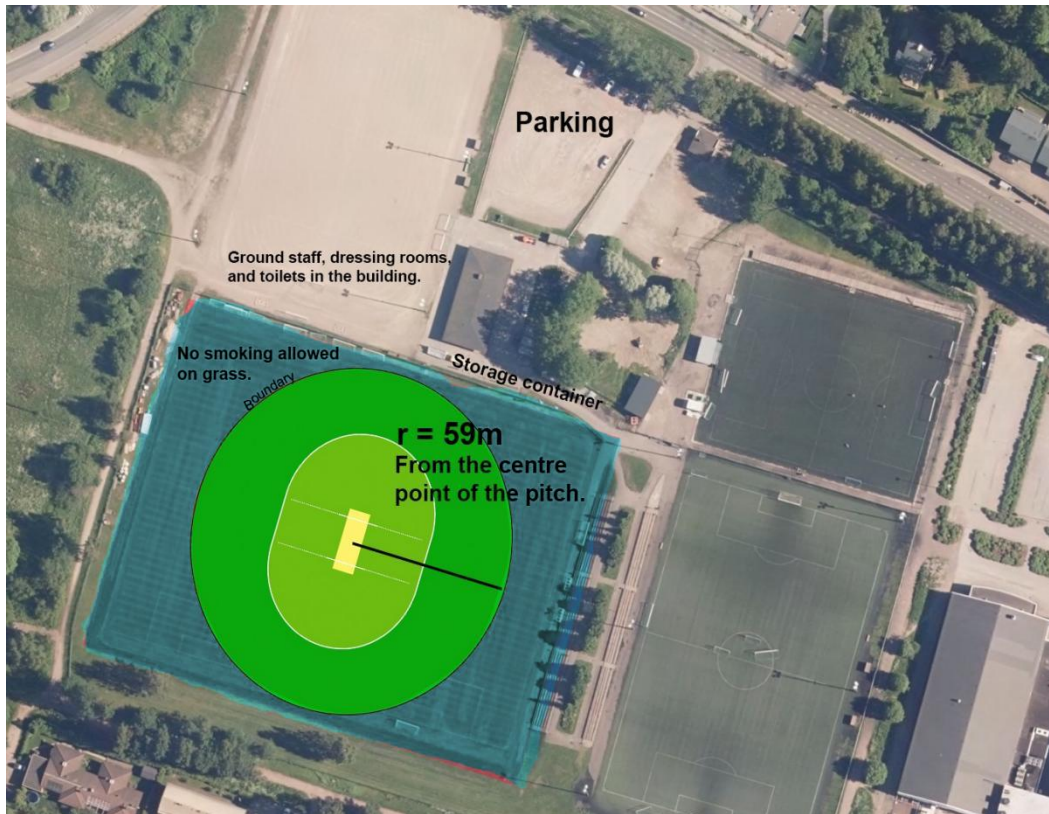
CRICKET FINLAND
GROUND-SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS
TIKKURILA CRICKET GROUND

1. Location of the ground

Venue name: Tikkurilan urheilupuisto / Tikkurila Sports Park

Address: Läntinen Valkoisenlähteentie 56, 01300 Vantaa.

3. Facilities

Dressing rooms, toilets, and the office of the ground staff are located in the maintenance building next to the ground.

Dressing rooms shall not be used for storing kit bags or other equipment during the match, as the rooms are also used by other teams/sports playing on neighbouring grounds.

Parking is allowed only on the parking lot behind the maintenance building. Do not park your car next to the maintenance building.

It is strictly forbidden to use any other part of the ground than an actual toilet as a toilet.

4. Ground preparation

Ask the ground staff in the service building to

- open the dressing rooms
- give you the radios from the charger in the office (radios are marked with CF)
- open the storage container housing the stumps, the scoreboard and other equipment

The equipment shall only be used for league matches sanctioned by Cricket Finland.

5. Field preparation

The field is prepared by the City of Vantaa ground staff according to specifications provided by Cricket Finland. Any questions regarding boundary placement and other details should be directed to the League Organization (LO).

If the teams notice problems in the field preparation, they should notify the umpires who will in turn inform the LO.

For Women's competition:

Mark the boundary, radius 50m from the center point of the pitch, with the cones/discs

6. Field-specific Playing Conditions

Bowling at the TCG is from both ends

The field of play is generally a circle with a radius of 59 meters.

Only coloured chalk is permitted to be used for marking stump positions when taking guard. Using permanent markers or anything else will be considered damaging the pitch (section 41.14 of the PCs) and wilful mistreatment of the cricket ground (section 42.2.1) and penalized accordingly.

7. Post-match duties

The captain of the home team is responsible for

- cleaning and storing the stumps, the bails, and the scoreboard in the storage container and asking the ground staff to lock the container
- taking the radios to the ground staff office, placing them in the charger and ensuring that red led (denoting charging in progress) in the charging base is lit for both radios
- **notifying the LO immediately after the match if any equipment malfunctioned or was broken during the match**
- making sure no trash is left on the ground

8. Smoking

Smoking is not allowed inside the fenced area of the ground. All cigarette butts must be properly extinguished and then placed in Cricket Finland red trashcan.

9. Fines for non-compliance

If any of the above instructions are not complied with, the penalty shall be

- 1st occurrence: the home team will receive first and last warning.
- 2nd occurrence: the home team will be levied with a fine of 35Euros per infraction.
- 3rd and each subsequent occurrence: the home team will be levied with a fine of 70Euros per infraction.
